PhD position in Immunology

A PhD position is available at the Department of Infection Biology, Universitätsklinikum Erlangen. The project is funded by the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft and will focus on regulation of B cell responses in type 2 immunity in the context of helminth infections and allergic inflammation.

The position is funded by the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft as part of a Transregional Collaborative Research Center (TRR130) where about 20 research groups study various aspects of B cell and plasma cell biology. The TRR130 has an integrated graduate school to provide a structured education program for PhD students.

We are looking for highly motivated candidates with a strong interest in cellular and molecular immunology. Experience in flow cytometry and use of in vivo models would be advantageous.

We offer a dynamic research environment with various collaboration partners. The position is available immediately. Salary will be according to the German TV-L system for up to 4-5 years.
